GUIDELINES

CITIZEN OF THE YEAR/ COMMUNITY SERVICE

1. Resident > 10 years (COTY).
2. History of community activity of at least five years.
3. An organization or group may be nominated for community service award.
4. Recipient one time (COTY).
5. Board has the right to nominate.
6. Board has the right to pass if there are no acceptable candidates.

BUSINESS PERSON OF THE YEAR

1. Must own/operate a business in Churchville-Riga in year of consideration.
2. Must have an active history in the business community five years.
3. Recipient one time.
4. Board has the right to nominate.
5. Board has the right to pass if no acceptable candidate is found.

CIVIC BEAUTIFICATION AWARD

1. Recipient's property must be in the physical confines of Churchville-Riga.
2. Property owner need not reside in Churchville-Riga.
3. Pertains to new or renovated property.
4. Project must be complete.
5. Non-profit organizations volunteering time and materials may be considered.
6. Municipal governments or school district may be considered.
7. New construction could include owner and/or builder and tenant.
8. Board has the right to nominate.
9. Board has the right to pass if no suitable candidate is found.
